

## **Overview**

The purpose of this course is to help you improve your overall English skills, especially your ability to speak. To achieve this, you will be given many opportunities to converse with your classmates and the instructor, a native English speaker from the United Kingdom (more specifically, England). By attending regularly and by participating enthusiastically in the class, you will most likely develop your fluency skills, build a stronger vocabulary, become a better listener, and learn some basic grammar. In this context, *fluency* refers to the speed and rhythm of your speech, and *building a stronger vocabulary* refers to learning new words and expressions. **Ultimately, communicating effectively is the main goal; you do not need to use perfect English (grammar) to achieve this!** As mentioned above, there is a lot of interaction in every class (talking to other students [and the instructor]); therefore, if you enjoy being sociable and communicating with others, you will hopefully have a lot of fun as well as improve your command of English!

The textbook for this course is **Active English Discussion 2**, **Second Edition** by Andrew Finch (Pearson/Longman). In **Intensive 1**, starting on September 1, we will focus on **units 1-9** (units 10-18 will be covered during the



next session, starting in November. Additional class materials will also be used throughout the 6-week course.

There are **five classes per week** (Monday to Friday), each lasting 50 minutes.

## **Class Content**

During classes, with the help of the teacher, you will:

- engage in conversations based on class materials and topics;
- analyze sample dialogues to learn everyday vocabulary and expressions;
- read short articles to expand your general vocabulary;
- share your opinions on topics and practice agreeing/disagreeing with classmates through mini-debates;
- learn conversation strategies to help you converse more effectively in English.
